Advising expedition in moving the Irving Street at Mount Pleasant Street loading zone to directly serve the south-west quadrant of 3100 Mount Pleasant Street

Resolved, ANC 1D advises the DC Department of Transportation (dDoT) to expedite the moving of the loading zone now on Irving Street at Mount Pleasant Street, after assuring feasibility, to directly serve the south-west quadrant of 3100 Mount Pleasant Street. 1D asks for the intercession of the District Council and Councilmembers Jim Graham and Tommy Wells in expediting this request.

Why: This southwest quadrant of 3100 Mount Pleasant Street, between Irving Street NW and an alley about a hundred yards north, includes several restaurants, a liquor store, and other stores. These stores require frequent deliveries, contractors, trades visits for repairs and upgrades, and trash hauls.

The arguments and observational evidence in previous 1D resolutions are included here by reference – those of February and March 15th.

This immediacy of this need has been reinforced by a large portion – often a majority – of participants at 1D meetings for the last five months. There is a petition of support for this request by a majority of neighboring merchants in this area.

Passed by 4 to 0 vote at the legally noticed, public meeting of ANC1D on April 19, 2011, with a quorum present. Voting “yes”: Commissioners McKay, Romero-Castillo, Edwards, Terrell.
